

CRYSTAL MAZE.

A tribute to the renowned show, teams must solve puzzles to earn themselves as many crystals as possible. Once the activities are complete, it's time to take on 'The Dome.'

Fun, fast-paced and exciting, this team building event will utilise your teams' skills, testing their communication, logic, co-ordination, time management and problem solving abilities. Visiting different zones: physical, mental, mystery and skill, the number of crystals collected depends on your performance. The more crystals the more time in 'The Dome', the event's fun and furious finale!

CHALLENGES WILL INCLUDE SOME OF THE FOLLOWING:

Well Balanced: Team members must pass various weighted objects to each other without tipping the see-saw.

Team Tower: You must work out how to re-build a tower in this test of logic.

Toxic Waste: Work out a maths formula so you can divide up the hazardous waste, safe for disposal.

Barbecue Brainteaser: Solve the puzzle and then use the tongs provided to put it in the correct place on the barbecue.

Stocks & Share: Once in the "stocks" you must complete the jigsaw as a team. With limited reach and movement, co-operation and communication is essential.

Turf Wars: Teams compete in a game of strategy and sabotage to plant bigger flowers than their neighbours!


InstruMental: Teams solve our music challenge in order to build the puzzle correctly and then play a tune!

Team Tent: Team members must follow verbal instructions from a team mate to assemble a tent, whilst blindfolded!

Bank Job (indoor alternative): Teams must communicate and share information, analyse clues and use their logic to solve the mystery – ensuring justice is done!

Team Skis (outdoor only): The whole team must position themselves onto some giant skis and complete an obstacle course.

The Dome: Once all activities are complete, you're ready to enter the inflatable crystal dome! As fans blow tickets into the air, you must work against the clock to collect as many gold tickets as possible, avoiding the silver ones. Whichever team has the most gold tickets, will be victorious becoming the proud winners of the much coveted Crystal Trophy!



MORSE CODEBUSTERS

All usual communications are down across the globe!

Your elite teams will need to tune into and decode urgent Morse transmissions from a network of covert agents, each holding a vital piece of the puzzle and crucial to completing a series of top secret challenges. This interactive event will demand seamless teamwork, razor-sharp strategic thinking and a good dose of fun, as teams master the art of decoding one of the oldest and most resilient forms of communication.

Your group will be divided into teams of approximately 10 guests, huddling around a dedicated command table, each equipped with a Radio Receiver that broadcasts signals both audibly and visually. The mission kicks off with a briefing on the fundamentals of Morse code – the legendary dot-and-dash system and the secrets to sending and receiving.

Each team will then intercept a series of encrypted messages from agents positioned in hotspots across the globe. They must tune into these transmissions on their Radio Receiver and swiftly decipher them. Once teams have cracked the code, decrypted messages must be rushed to `Samuel Morse,` our designated Intelligence Officer at the front of the room. In exchange for a correctly decoded message, teams will receive a top-secret challenge to be completed back at their command tables. Only when each message is accurately deciphered and its subsequent challenge conquered, will teams unlock the next piece of the mission.

Teams will have a strict 2-hour window to decipher as many messages and conquer their accompanying challenges as possible. The team that successfully deciphers the most messages and submits the most correct challenge solutions will be hailed 'The Ultimate Morse Code Busters'!

A body has been discovered in suspicious circumstances!

Your venue is turned into an incident room and the delegates are now the detectives!! Wearing forensic investigator suits, they have to unravel what led to the death and who is the prime suspect. Led by real Scotland Yard trained detectives, the evidence will build through the course of the event as they analyse witness statements, bank and phone records, CCTV and police intelligence to create the timeline of events. They will also use real forensic techniques, visiting the crime scene, searching for further clues. Here they will dust for finger-marks and use odontology, shoe mark analysis and DNA to compare against the main suspects. The teams then present their timelines and theories and hear from the suspects in interview. The closest team to the truth will be the winners!!

EXAMPLE ITINERARY

- Introductions from our detective presenter
- Guests split into teams
- Examine the initial evidence and suggest lines of enquiry
- Review full evidential package together as a team
- 'Suit up' into real forensic coveralls, attend the crime scene, search for clues, take fingerprints, powder for finger marks, hear from witnesses, obtain custody samples from suspects including shoe marks and odontology
- Compare to evidence at the crime scene, produce and present team theory and hear from suspects in police interview
- Debrief and winning team announced!
